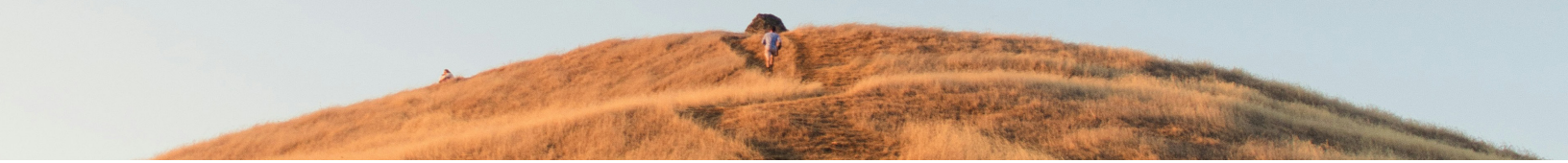




Write Your Life Code

WHAT'S THE CODE YOU LIVE BY—AND DOES

Use this resource to brainstorm and write out a code of life based in God's Word and applicable to your specific life calling and mission.

Reflect:

When you make decisions (big or small), what principles do you tend to follow?

If someone asked, "What do you want to be known for?", how would you answer?

Realign:

Which of the above codes or values reflect God's Word, and which might need rethinking in light of Scripture?

What does God say is the purpose of the Christian's life? (Some example verses Matthew 22: 34-40; Matthew 28: 16-20; 2 Corinthians 5:20; Romans 8:29, and verses from my code in the blog post are a great place to start, too!)

Reimagine:

In addition to your answer above, are there other “life verses” that have been defining for you over the years, and why have they been important to you?

Think about how these verses could apply in different spheres where God has placed you. Write some thoughts here.
